HPFi (High Point Furniture Industries) is pleased to announce that there is no exposure to any chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity by physical contact, respiration or ingestion in the final state of any HPFi product.

Effective August 30, 2018, the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) adopted revisions to California Proposition 65 (Prop 65) that require notification when the presence of chemicals exceed specific levels. Additionally, the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 requires that the Governor of California revise and republish, at least once per year, this list of chemicals known to the State to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity above certain levels.

“The State of California is leading the way in identifying chemicals and the specific toxicity levels that lead to the development of cancer(s) and/or an inability to reproduce,” according to Tom Carrigan, Vice President of Marketing for HPFi. “We are happy to comply with the new Prop 65 requirements, but even more pleased to know that those who use our products are not exposed to unsafe chemical levels.”
